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Bishopsgate Ward Club Hon. Treasurer's Report For the Year Ended 31 March 2023

I am pleased to report that the Club accounts are now showing more usual activity after the COVID disruptions and a bit of catch up with increased donations and a higher number of guests at our events which have led to an overall deficit for the year but that is well covered by our healthy reserves.

Most of the Club's assets are held in an interest-bearing reserve account with our bankers and in Government Stock. The Government stock was coming up for maturity in September 2023 so to take advantage of a satisfactory sale price and the current higher interest rates, a sale of the stock held and purchase of 34,000 new 3.5% 22/01/45 Gilts was executed.

The club has enjoyed just over a 20% return in income generation over the years the stock was held and have preserved the capital value of the investment.

I continue to be proud of being the Honorary Treasurer of our excellent Club and many thanks to Adrian Houstoun our Examiner and long-time member, since 1998, for examining the accounts.
